### ARTICLE II, of Bylaws:

Section 4. FIRM MEMBERSHIP - a corporation or partnership may, upon payment of the initiation fee required for resident members, designate one representative in its employ for membership, who, upon election to membership, shall have the rights and privileges of a resident member. The owner of a firm membership shall pay dues of a regular member for its representative. In case of death, resignation or expulsion of a representative above mentioned, the corporation or partnership may propose the name of another representative in its employ who shall be elected to membership in the same manner as individual members, and upon the election of a new representative, such person shall be entitled to all of the privileges of the Club as may be determined from time to time by the Board of Directors. The corporation or partnership may have additional corporate memberships upon the same terms and conditions as provided herein and said corporation or partnership shall guarantee the payment of all indebtedness of its representatives.

Section 13. RESIGNATION - Any member of the Club may resign from membership by written notice delivered to the Secretary of the Club; provided, however, that no resignation shall become effective until all current dues and any other indebtedness then owed to the Club by such member shall have been paid in full by such resigning member.

Section 14. EFFECT OF DEATH, EXPULSION OR RESIGNATION - Upon the death, expulsion or resignation of a member, all rights and interest of such member in the property of the Club shall cease; dues shall cease at the end of the month in which a death or expulsion occurred. Upon resignation of a member, dues shall cease at the end of the month in which the resignation is accepted by the Board of Directors.

A resident membership, firm membership or multiple membership which is or was in good standing at the time of its resignation or his death may transfer such membership including all rights and interest without the payment of a membership fee provided that the transferee makes application for membership, is accepted according to the provisions of the Bylaws of the Club and pays a transfer fee in such amount as the board of directors may direct.

Any resident membership, firm membership, or multiple memberships may be returned to the Secretary of the Club for reissuance under the direction of the Board of Directors. The order in which such membership shall be reissued is determined by the order in which such memberships are tendered to the Secretary with the first tendered being eligible for reissuance first and the others following in order of their tender to the Secretary. When such memberships have been reissued and the club paid all required fees for such reissuance, a full refund shall be promptly made to the former membership owner of the estate of a deceased former member. Such refund, however, shall be in the amount of all membership fees and assessments, if any, paid in by such former member less any applicable taxes thereon.
