ARTICLE II, of Bylaws:

Section 3b. JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP - Any natural person over twenty-one years of age but not yet thirty-five years of age residing or having his or her principal business activity in Potter or Randall County, Texas, shall be eligible for Junior Membership. Such member shall have no voice or vote in any meeting of the Club membership, nor shall such member have, or acquire any right, title or interest in, or to, any of the assets or properties of the Club, nor shall such member be eligible for election to the board of directors or any office of the Club until his thirty-fifth birthday. At that time, this membership shall be converted to a Resident Membership and the member shall pay the dues of a Resident Member. Failure to pay balance of fees when due shall forfeit this membership.

Section 13. RESIGNATION - Any member of the Club may resign from membership by written notice delivered to the Secretary of the Club; provided, however, that no resignation shall become effective until all current dues and any other indebtedness then owed to the Club by such member shall have been paid in full by such resigning member.

Section 14. EFFECT OF DEATH, EXPULSION OR RESIGNATION - Upon the death, expulsion or resignation of a member, all rights and interest of such member in the property of the Club shall cease; dues shall cease at the end of the month in which a death or expulsion occurred. Upon resignation of a member, dues shall cease at the end of the month in which the resignation is accepted by the Board of Directors.
